## PRIVACY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 (“GDPR”)

Consent upon the release of the above data is optional; however, failure to provide the requested data or providing the same partially or inaccurately, may make it impossible to perform the contractual services referred to herein.

The data controller is Gemide S.r.l., Tax Id. No. and V.A.T. No. 13340830150, with registered office in Milan, Via Ranzoni n. 5, which will be storing any data collected, including by electronic means, for the purpose of performing the assignment received and to communicate with the data subject in compliance with the guarantees of confidentiality and security measures required by applicable legislation for the period of time necessary to pursue its processing purposes.

Pursuant to Articles 15-22 of the GDPR, in relation to Personal Data, the data subject is entitled to the following rights regarding Privacy:

Art. 15 GDPR – Right of access: right to obtain from the Controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data and information regarding the processing;

Art. 16 GDPR – Right to rectification: right to obtain from the Controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her and right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement.

Art. 17 GDPR - Right to erasure (‘right to be forgotten’): right to obtain from the Controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay and the Controller shall have the obligation to erase personal data without undue delay;

Art. 18 GDPR - Right to restriction of processing: right to obtain from the Controller restriction of processing where one of the following applies: (a) the accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject, for a period enabling the Controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data; (b) the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead; (c) the Controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims; (d) the data subject has objected to processing pursuant to Article 21, GDPR, pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the Controller override those of the data subject;

Art. 20 GDPR - Right to data portability: right to receive the personal data concerning him or her in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided. In exercising his or her right to data portability pursuant to paragraph 1, the data subject shall have the right to have the personal data transmitted directly from one controller to another, where technically feasible;

Art. 21 GDPR - Right to object: right to object, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her which is based on point (e) or (f) of Article 6(1), including profiling based on those provisions;

Art. 22 GDPR - Automated individual decision-making, including profiling: right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning him or her or similarly significantly affects him or her.
